Filled with surprises, action, humour and heart, **WALL•E is out of this world!**

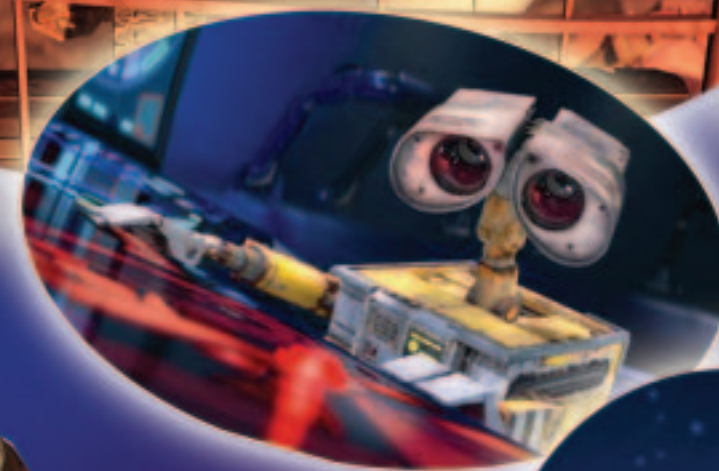
## FUN FACT
